Scenario 1: in-school classes resume (normal operations)

- Local school authorities may need to adjust their school calendars and/or the number and length of instructional days, within the parameters of all contractual agreements with school authority employees, to address content in subject areas and any learning gaps from the 2019-20 school year. School authorities must follow public health measures related to physical distancing for student learning and extra curricular activities, including guidelines and standards on the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Scenario 2: in-school classes partially resume

- School authorities must follow public health measures related to physical distancing for student learning and extra curricular activities, including guidelines and standards on the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Scenario 3: at-home learning (schools remain closed to in-class learning)

- All school authorities offer at-home learning opportunities to their students such as a Virtual School Platform like the indionetwork.com site being used by Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation, or connection through applications like Zoom, Microsoft Meeting, Gotomeet, Adobe Connect, or Google Classroom.
